CLIMATE CHANGE & ENERGY

Aletsch Bahnen AG is committed to public transport and promotes its use throughout the completely car-free area. We collaborate with SBB and MGB, offer incentives for the use of public transport and ensure seamless connections to the cable cars with the provision of modern infrastructure such as the public transport hub in Fiesch. The adoption of modern technologies and the continuous modernisation of our systems result in enhanced efficiency and reduced carbon emissions. The additional use of photovoltaics is a key component of our strategy for the future.

WATER & WATER MANAGEMENT

Water is crucial for winter tourism. It makes activities possible and guarantees a constant supply of artificial snow. Aletsch Bahnen AG obtains its entire electricity from regional hydropower and draws all water for snowmaking from local lakes in the ski area, thus minimising transport routes and environmental impact. The ongoing modernisation of our snowmaking infrastructure makes for additional efficiency gains. Our mountain stations are also equipped with systems for grey water recycling.

Landscapes and biodiversity influence the climate and are central to the ecosystem. Aletsch Bahnen AG is committed to the protection of biodiversity through consistent renaturalisation and environmental construction monitoring. With initiatives such as the Moosfluh Geology Walkway and the Bettmerhorn & Eggishorn Glacier Worlds (from 2026), we are raising awareness of climate change and its impact on nature in the region. We also go one step further, continuously investing a significant proportion of our operating profit in refurbishments and further developments in the area.
